STAGE MAKEUP FUNDAMENTALS FORT WAYNE CIVIC THEATRE 9:30-10:30 AM

Learn the 'how-tos' and 'what not to dos' of stage makeup with **KATHY CRIM**. Powerful stage lighting systems tend to remove all warm tones from a performer's complexion and will eliminate shadows and lines. Makeup restores this color and defines the facial features to ensure a natural appearance that can be seen by all audience members.

SENSORY THEATRE WORKSHOP KITCHEN SINK THEATRE 9:15-10:15 AM

Join the Kitchen Sink Theatre team, **GLORIA MINNICH**, **MADDIE MILLER**, **AARON MANN**, AND **SEAN FINDLEY** in discovering the joys of sensory theatre, where the rules of "traditional" theatre don't apply. INTRO TO MEISNER ACTING SUMMIT CITY MUSIC THEATRE 9:15-10:30 AM

In this introductory workshop to the Meisner acting technique, join GAVIN THOMAS DREW as students delve into the fundamental principles of truthful, spontaneous acting. Developed by Sanford Meisner, this approach emphasizes truthful behavior in imaginary circumstances, focusing on the actor's ability to listen and respond authentically in the moment. Through a series of exercises and improvisations, participants will learn to connect emotionally with their scene partners, tap into their instincts, and cultivate a deeper understanding of character and relationships. Whether you're a beginner or an experienced actor looking to refine your craft, this workshop offers a dynamic exploration of the Meisner technique's transformative power in performance. CONTEMPORARY DANCE MUSICALS FORT WAYNE DANCE COLLECTIVE 9:15-10:30 AM

Taught by **KALLEAH WILFONG**, this dance class is for students ages 8 through teen interested in learning dance techniques from contemporary musicals like *Six*, & *Juliet*, and *Hamilton*. From auditions to closing night, this workshop will walk you through the show life of a Stage Manager. Have you ever wondered "What does a Stage Manager do"? **SHAWNA ROBERTS** will walk you through the paperwork, organization skills, the basics of setting up a call book, and you'll touch on what tech week looks like from the eyes of a Stage Manager. This workshop is set up as an overview of what to expect while stage managing, with a focus on the front end (pretech) process.

In this dynamic vocal audition masterclass, participants are guided through the nuances of stage presence, vocal technique, and emotional storytelling necessary for an unforgettable vocal audition. Participants are encouraged to prepare a 60-90 second audition cut in the musical style of their choosing, providing sheet music with cuts cleanly marked. With Jodi's musical prowess and Andy's seasoned expertise in stage performance, participants will refine their audition repertoire through personalized feedback and collaborative exploration. Participants will harness their unique talents, honing them into captivating audition pieces that will empower performers to shine brightly in any audition space. Only open to 6 participants, observers are welcome!

STAGE MANAGEMENT 201: HOLD! -A STAGE MANAGER'S GUIDE TO TECH WEEK FORT WAYNE CIVIC THEATRE 2:15-3:45 PM

This workshop is for those who are interested in the technical side of the Stage Manager. Take a deeper dive with **SHAWNA ROBERTS** into setting up a call book, running tech week, and calling a show. You'll go over how to get ready for a week of multi-tasking and decision making, while updating your cues in your show book. Tech week is a different world when sitting at the Stage Manager desk, but when the show is yours, while you may not take a bow, that applause is for you as well!

DRAMATIC STORYTELLING INDIANA MUSIC THEATRE FOUNDATION 2:15-3:30 PM

In this workshop, you'll be taking a crash course in the basics of writing new works for the theatre. Local playwright and Dramatists Guild member, **DARBY LECLEAR**, will walk you through the foundations of dramatic storytelling and give you the tools to create compelling characters, structure your plot, and write engaging dialogue - all with the goal of getting your words on the page and ready for the stage. Whether you're a long-time writer or a complete beginner, join us to improve your craft and get your ideas moving!

FUNDAMENTALS OF DESIGNING FOR COSTUMES FORT WAYNE CIVIC THEATRE 2:15-3:45 PM

SARAH MOLONEY will cover the elements needed to consider when designing costumes for live theatre. Some elements include basic script analysis, understanding your production team, considering technical elements, understanding comfort through wardrobe, and the artistic process involved in conceiving and conveying your costume design. This class will include some tips and tricks to design and sketching but will cover a vast array of what it takes to start the process. If you have ever wanted a peek at what it takes to costume design a full show, this class is a great way to look at the care and practice that is taken in producing your own costume designs!
